

Privacy Policy

Aeaea Technology Limited (“OHDAT”, “we ” “ us ”), a Hong Kong incorporated company, is informing you of our policies regarding collection, use, retention, disclosure and/or transfer of personal information we receive from users (“users” or “you”) of our website ohdat.io and corresponding applications (the “Platform”) and online services (collectively, the “Services”). Personal information will be collected only for lawful and relevant purposes and all practicable steps will be taken to ensure that personal data held by us is accurate. We will use your personal information which we may from time to time collect in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

1. Types of Data OHDAT may Collect

“Personal Information” means data that allows someone to identify or contact you, for example, your name, address, telephone number, email address, as well as any other non-public information about you that is associated with or linked to any of the foregoing data. With respect to EU data subjects, “personal information,” as used in this Privacy Policy, is equivalent to “personal data” as defined in the European Union General Data Protection Regulation.

“Anonymous Data” means data, including aggregated and de-identified data, that is not associated with or linked to your Personal Information; Anonymous Data does not, by itself, permit the identification of individual persons. OHDAT may collect Personal Information and Anonymous Data, as described below.

1.1 Information You Provide to OHDAT

- a. **OHDAT may collect Personal Information from you, such as your email and mailing addresses, Ethereum address, and OHDAT account name and password when you create an account to log in to our Platform (“Account”).**
- b. If you use our Services on your mobile device, OHDAT may collect your phone number and the unique device ID number and Internet Protocol (“IP”) address.
- c. Our Service allows you to store preferences such as how the content is displayed, your location, safe search settings, notification settings, and favorite widgets. OHDAT may associate these choices with your ID, browser or mobile device, and you can edit these preferences at any time.
- d. When connecting to our Services via a service provider that uniquely identifies your mobile device, OHDAT may receive this identification and use it to offer extended services and/or functionality.

- e. If you provide OHDAT with feedback or contact OHDAT via email, OHDAT will collect your name and email address, as well as any other content included in the email, in order to send you a reply.
- f. OHDAT may also collect other types of Personal Information that you provide to OHDAT voluntarily, such as your operating system and version, registration number, Ethereum address, and other requested information if you contact OHDAT via email regarding support for the Services.
- g. OHDAT may also collect Personal Information at other points in our Services that state that Personal Information is being collected.

1.2 Information Collected via Technology. As you navigate through and interact with our Services, OHDAT may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns, including the following information:

- a. To make our Services more useful to you, our servers (which may be hosted by a third party service provider) may collect information from you, including your browser type, operating system, IP address (a number that is automatically assigned to your device when you use the internet, which may vary from session to session), domain name, Ethereum address, wallet type, and/or a date/time stamp for your visit.
- b. As is true of most OHDAT websites, OHDAT may gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes IP addresses, browser type, internet service provider ("ISP"), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and click stream data. OHDAT may use this information to analyze trends, administer the Services, gather demographic information about our user base as a whole, and better tailor our Services to our users' needs. For example, some of the information may be collected so that when you visit the Services, it will recognize you and the information may then be used to display advertisements and other information appropriate to your interests.
- c. OHDAT may use cookies to collect information. "Cookies" are small pieces of information that a OHDAT website sends to your computer's hard drive while you are viewing the OHDAT website. OHDAT may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Services. This type of information is collected to make the Services more useful to you and to tailor the experience with OHDAT to meet your special interests and needs.

- d. In addition, OHDAT may use “Pixel Tags” (also referred to as clear Gifs, web beacons, or web bugs). “Pixel Tags” are tiny graphic images with a unique identifier, similar in function to Cookies, that are used to track online movements of web users. In contrast to Cookies, which are stored on a user’s computer hard drive, Pixel Tags are embedded invisibly in web pages. Pixel Tags also allow OHDAT to send email messages in a format users can read, and they tell OHDAT whether emails have been opened to ensure that OHDAT is sending only messages that are of interest to our users. OHDAT may use this information to reduce or eliminate messages sent to a user. OHDAT will not tie the information gathered by Pixel Tags to our users’ Personal Information.
 - e. OHDAT does not currently respond to “do not track” signals or other mechanisms that might enable users to opt out of tracking on our site.
 - f. In addition to the tracking technologies OHDAT places, other providers may set their own cookies or similar tools when you visit our Platform. This includes third party analytic services, including but not limited to Google Analytic (“Analytic Services”), that OHDAT engages to help analyze how users use the Services. OHDAT may receive reports based on these parties’ use of these tools on an individual or aggregate basis. OHDAT uses the information OHDAT obtains from Analytic Services only to improve our Services. The information generated by the Cookies or other technologies about your use of our Service (the “Analytics Information”) is transmitted to the Analytics Services. The Analytics Services use Analytics Information to compile reports on user activity. The Analytics Services may also transfer information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process Analytics Information on their behalf. Each Analytics Services’ ability to use and share Analytics Information is restricted by such Analytics Services’ terms of services and privacy policy. By using our Services, you consent to the processing of data about you by Analytics Services in the manner and for the purposes set out above.
- 1.3 OHDAT may receive Personal Information and/or Anonymous Data about you from third party that provide our Services by way of a co-branded or private-labeled OHDAT website or that offer their products and/or services through link on our Platform. In particular, MetaMask and other wallets provide OHDAT with your Ethereum address and certain other information you choose to share with MetaMask and other wallets. These third parties may supply OHDAT with Personal Information. OHDAT may add this to the information OHDAT has already collected from you via our Services in order to improve it. OHDAT does not collect Personal Information automatically, but may tie the information that OHDAT collects automatically to Personal

Information about you that OHDAT collects from other sources or that you provide to OHDAT.

2. Use of Your Personal Information

a. In general, Personal Information you submit to OHDAT is used by OHDAT either to respond to requests that you make, or to aid OHDAT in serving you better. The ways that OHDAT uses your Personal Information include but not limited to:

- (1) facilitate the creation of and secure your Account on our Platform;
- (2) identify you as a user in our system and Platform;
- (3) provide improved administration of our Services;
- (4) provide the Services you request, including but not limited to facilitating your cryptocurrency transactions through MetaMask or other wallets that recognized by our Platform;
- (5) improve the quality of experience when you interact with our Platform;
- (6) send you a welcome email to verify ownership of the email address provided when you created Account;
- (7) protect you and other users from any conduct that violates the Terms of Services or to prevent abuse or harassment of any user;
- (8) display your user name next to the digital assets you wish to sell on the OHDAT Platform;
- (9) send you administrative email notifications, such as security or support and maintenance advisories;
- (10) send you email notifications related to actions on Services, including but not limited to notifications of offers on your digital assets;
- (11) respond to your inquiries related to employment opportunities or other requests through your Account;
- (12) make telephone calls to you, from time to time, as a part of secondary fraud protection or to solicit your feedback;
- (13) send newsletters, surveys, offers, and other promotional materials related to our Services and for other marketing purposes of OHDAT; and
- (14) use for compliance, fraud prevention, and safety.

OHDAT may use your Personal Information to contact you about our own and third parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you.

- b. OHDAT may create Anonymous Data records from Personal Information by excluding information (such as your name) that makes the data personally identifiable to you. OHDAT may use this Anonymous Data to analyze requests and usage patterns so that OHDAT may enhance the content of our Services and improve Services navigation. OHDAT reserves the right to use Anonymous Data for other purposes and to disclose Anonymous Data to third parties without restriction.

3. Disclosure of Your Personal Information

OHDAT may disclose your Personal Information as described below and as described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy.

- a. Third Party Service Providers. OHDAT may share your Personal Information with third party service providers: (1) to provide you with the Services that OHDAT offer you through our Services; (2) to conduct quality assurance testing; (3) to facilitate creation of accounts; (4) to provide technical support; and/or (5) to provide other services to the OHDAT.
- b. OHDAT may share some or all of your Personal Information with our parent company, subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under a common control (“Affiliates”), in which case OHDAT will require our Affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy.
- c. OHDAT may share some or all of your Personal Information in connection with or during negotiation of any merger, financing, acquisition or dissolution transaction or proceeding involving sale, transfer, divestiture, or disclosure of all or a portion of our business or assets. In the event of an insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership, Personal Information may also be transferred as a business asset. If a third party acquires our company, business, or assets, that party will possess the Personal Information collected by OHDAT and will assume the rights and obligations regarding your Personal Information as described in this Privacy Policy.
- d. Regardless of any choices you make regarding your Personal Information (as described below), OHDAT may disclose Personal Information if we believe in good faith that such disclosure is necessary (a) in connection with any legal investigation; (b) to comply with relevant applicable laws or to respond to subpoenas or warrants served on OHDAT; (c) to protect or defend the rights or property of OHDAT or users of the Services; and/or (d) to investigate or assist in preventing any violation or potential violation of the law, this Privacy Policy, or our Terms of Services.
- e. OHDAT may also disclose your Personal Information, to fulfill the purpose for which you provide it; for purpose disclosed by OHDAT when you provide it; or with your consent. OHDAT will not sell your Personal Information.

4. Outside OHDAT Websites

Our Services may contain links to other websites owned and/or operated by third parties (the “**Outside OHDAT Websites**”). When you click on a link to any Outside OHDAT Website or location, you will leave our Services and go to another platform, and another entity may collect Personal Information or Anonymous Data from you. You may also find marketplaces powered by the Services on Outside OHDAT Website or application. OHDAT has no control over, does not review, and cannot be responsible for, these Outside OHDAT Websites or their content. Please be aware that the terms of this Privacy Policy do not apply to these Outside OHDAT Website, application or content, or to any collection of your Personal Information after you click on links to such Outside OHDAT Websites or application. OHDAT encourages you to read the privacy policies of every website you visit. The links to third party websites or locations are for your convenience and do not signify our endorsement of such third parties or their services, content or the Outside OHDAT Websites.

5. Third-Party Wallet Extensions

For conducting cryptocurrency transactions OHDAT uses third-party electronic wallet extensions such as (but not limited to) MetaMask; your interactions with MetaMask and/or any third-party electronic wallet extensions are governed by the applicable privacy policies on those third-parties.

6. Options Regarding Use of Information

You have the following options regarding the use of information on our Services:

- a. Where you have given your consent and have not subsequently opted out, OHDAT will periodically send you free, opt-in newsletters and/or emails that directly promote the use of our Services. When you receive such newsletters or promotional communications from OHDAT, you may indicate a preference to stop receiving further communications from OHDAT and you will have the opportunity to “opt-out” by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the communication you receive or by contacting OHDAT directly (please see contact information in our website). Despite your indicated email preferences, OHDAT may send you occasional service related communications, including notices of updates to our Terms of Services or Privacy Policy.
- b. If you decide at any time that you no longer wish to accept Cookies from our Services for any of the purposes described above, then you can instruct your browser, by changing its settings, to stop accepting Cookies or to prompt you before accepting a Cookie from the OHDAT websites you visit. You should read your browser’s technical information. If you do not accept Cookies, however, you may not be able to use all portions of the Services or all functionality of the Services. If you have any questions about how to disable or modify Cookies, please contact OHDAT at the address given on our website.

7. Information Access and Control

You can view, access, edit, or delete your Personal Information for many aspects of the Services via your account settings page. You can also make choices about OHDAT's use of your data. You can choose whether you would like to receive marketing communications from OHDAT, opt out from receiving marketing communications from OHDAT by using the opt-out link on the communication, or by visiting your account settings page. OHDAT may retain an archived copy of your records as required by law or for legitimate business purposes.

- a. You can access and modify your Personal Information on your account settings page.
- b. You can request a copy of your Personal Information by contacting OHDAT [by email](#) and including "Please send me my Personal Information" in the subject line. OHDAT will verify your ability to access the email sent to the email address provided, then send you a digital export of the data OHDAT holds that is associated with your email address. OHDAT will use reasonable efforts to respond to your request within **【 3 】** business days, but in all events within **【 10 】** business days of our receipt of the request.
- c. You can delete your Personal Information on your account settings page. Alternatively, you may request that OHDAT delete your Personal Information by contacting OHDAT by email and including "Please delete my Personal Information" in the subject line. OHDAT will verify your ability to access the email sent to the email address provided, then delete the Personal Information associated with your email address. OHDAT will use reasonable efforts to respond to your request within **【 3 】** business days, but in all events within **【 10 】** business days of our receipt of the request.
- d. A reasonable fee may be charged to offset the administrative and actual costs incurred in complying with your Personal Information access requests.

8. Information Retention

OHDAT may retain your Personal Information as long as you continue to use the Services, have an account with OHDAT, or for as long as is necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy. Should your account or relationship with OHDAT be cancelled or terminated at any time, we shall cease processing your Personal Information as soon as reasonably practicable following such cancellation or termination, provided that OHDAT may keep copies of your Personal Information as is reasonably required for archival purposes, for use in relation to any actual or potential dispute, for the purpose of compliance with applicable laws and regulations and for the purpose of enforcing any agreement OHDAT has with you, for protecting the rights or safety of OHDAT, for protecting the rights or safety of the employees of OHDAT, for tax or compliance reason, for

legal or regulatory reasons, for legitimate and lawful business purposes and for performing or discharging the functions, obligations or responsibilities of OHDAT.

9. Information Protection

OHDAT cares about the security of your information and use physical, administrative, and technological safeguards to preserve the integrity and security of all information collected through our OHDAT Platform. However, no security system is impenetrable and OHDAT cannot guarantee the security of our systems 100%. In the event that any Personal Information is compromised as a result of a breach of security, OHDAT will take steps to investigate the situation and, where appropriate, notify those individuals whose information may have been compromised and take other steps, in accordance with any applicable laws and regulations.

10.A Note About Children

OHDAT does not intentionally gather Personal Information from visitors who are under the age of 18 or any other age that could be legally defined/protected as a juvenile or minor according to the applicable law. If such a juvenile or minor submits Personal Information to OHDAT and OHDAT learns that the Personal Information is the information of a juvenile or minor, OHDAT will attempt to delete the information as soon as possible. If you believe that OHDAT might have any Personal Information from such a juvenile or minor, please contact OHDAT at the address indicated in the “Contact Us” section below.

11.To Users Outside of the Hong Kong

You acknowledge and agree that your Personal Information may be processed for the purposes identified in the Privacy Policy by visiting the Services and providing. In addition, your Personal Information may be processed in the country or area in which it was collected and in other countries, including the United States and Europe, where laws regarding processing of Personal Information may be more or less stringent than the laws in your country. By providing your data, you consent to such transfer.

12.Changes to This Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time for any reason. OHDAT will notify you of any changes to our Privacy Policy by posting the new Privacy Policy at our Platform. The date the Privacy Policy was last revised is identified at the beginning of this Privacy Policy. You are responsible for ensuring that OHDAT has an up-to-date active and deliverable email address for you, and for periodically visiting our Services and this Privacy Policy to check for any changes.

13.Compliance with laws and regulations

OHDAT may be required to retain, process and/or disclose your Personal Information in order to comply with applicable laws and regulations or in order to

comply with a court order, subpoena or other legal process (whether in Hong Kong or elsewhere), or to comply with a request by a government authority, law enforcement agency or similar body (whether situated in Hong Kong or elsewhere). OHDAT may need to disclose your Personal Information in order to enforce any agreement with you, protect the rights, property or safety of OHDAT, or the rights, property or safety of the employees of OHDAT.
